

Declines in COVID-19 hospitalizations continue for the fourteenth straight week. This downward trend started on or about December 17, 2020, and while the decent is slowing down, the numbers continue to shrink.




There is a sense of optimism throughout the state and throughout the nation. Airports reported screening 1.36 million people last Friday. This is the highest (non-holiday) number since March 2020 and possibly a positive signal for Las Vegas/ Clark County tourism.

Regional COVID-19 Hospitalizations as of Mar. 16, 2021



Total COVID patients, (confirmed) dropped another 50 week-over-week. There is no change in the total number of patients requiring intensive care, from last week's report.


Emergency Department visits for COVID-19 - related symptoms remained in the range of 8-9% of all visits. This remains consistent with last week's reported numbers.



Severe COVID-19 - related cases continue to decrease in the older populations. We continue to hypothesize that this is a result of the vaccination campaigns. Persons in the 20- to 59-year-old age groupings are experiencing an increase in the percentages of hospitalizations.




Northern Data Set



In the north, both Carson and Washoe continue to have hospitalized cases. **Washoe** has 18 confirmed cases and 2 suspected. Nine patients require the ICU.

Carson City has 8 confirmed and 2 suspected cases. Two patients require the ICU.

Southern Data Set



In **Clark County**, 216 confirmed and 60 suspected COVID-19 patients are hospitalized. Seventy-two require intensive care with 34 on ventilators.

These numbers represent a drop from last week of 38 confirmed cases and 7 patients on ventilators. Suspected cases have increased by 8 and ICU use remains unchanged.

Rural Data Set



Douglas, Nye, and Elko Counties are the only rural areas with hospitalized COVID-19 patients.

Douglas has 6 confirmed, 1 in the ICU. **Nye** has 2 suspected cases and, **Elko** has 4 confirmed cases.

Nevada's Roadmap to Recovery transition plan was updated on March 15, 2021. Each county will be required to follow a five-step plan to receive local control via a delegation of authority from the Governor. One step in the process will require endorsements from health districts, school districts, city managers and the hospital association.
