Note: The treating physician at the hospital may release the patient at any time during this process without court authorization.

Note: Approximately 388 petitions are filed each week in Clark County. Of those 388 cases, approximately 75% are dismissed prior to the hearing because the patient has been discharged from the hospital.

On average, 3.5 people are involuntarily admitted each week in Clark County.
