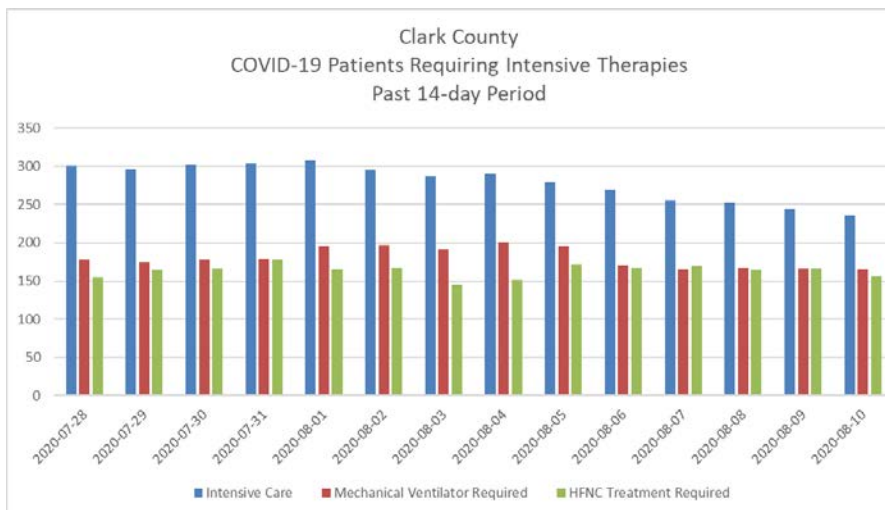
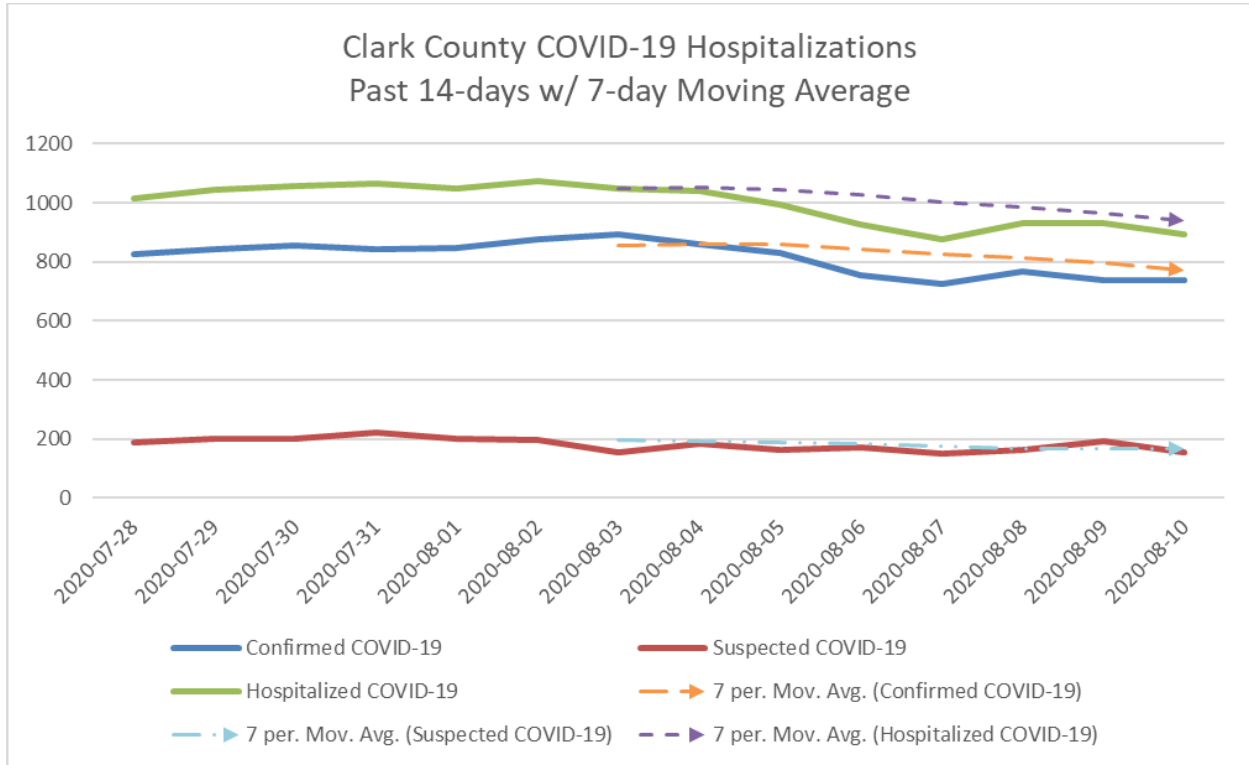
Nevada continues to experience a decrease in COVID-19 hospitalizations over the past 14-day period.

The assessment of overall statewide hospital capacity is currently rated as fair, with the caveat that some individual facilities within southern Nevada are experiencing stress due to high occupancy

rates in both the general hospital and intensive care units. Staffing shortages have also been reported in approximately five hospitals throughout the state.

Nevada continues to have capacity and capability to manage all-cause hospitalizations at this time.

Clark County Data Set

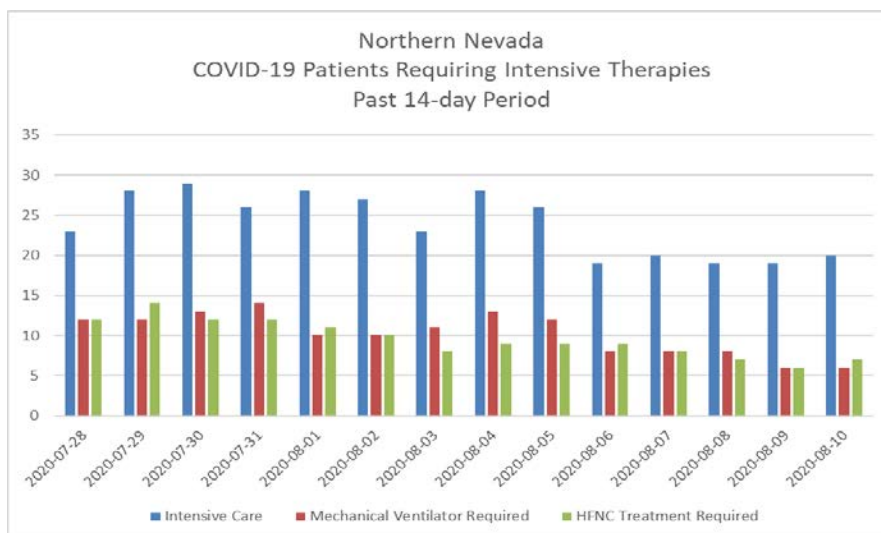
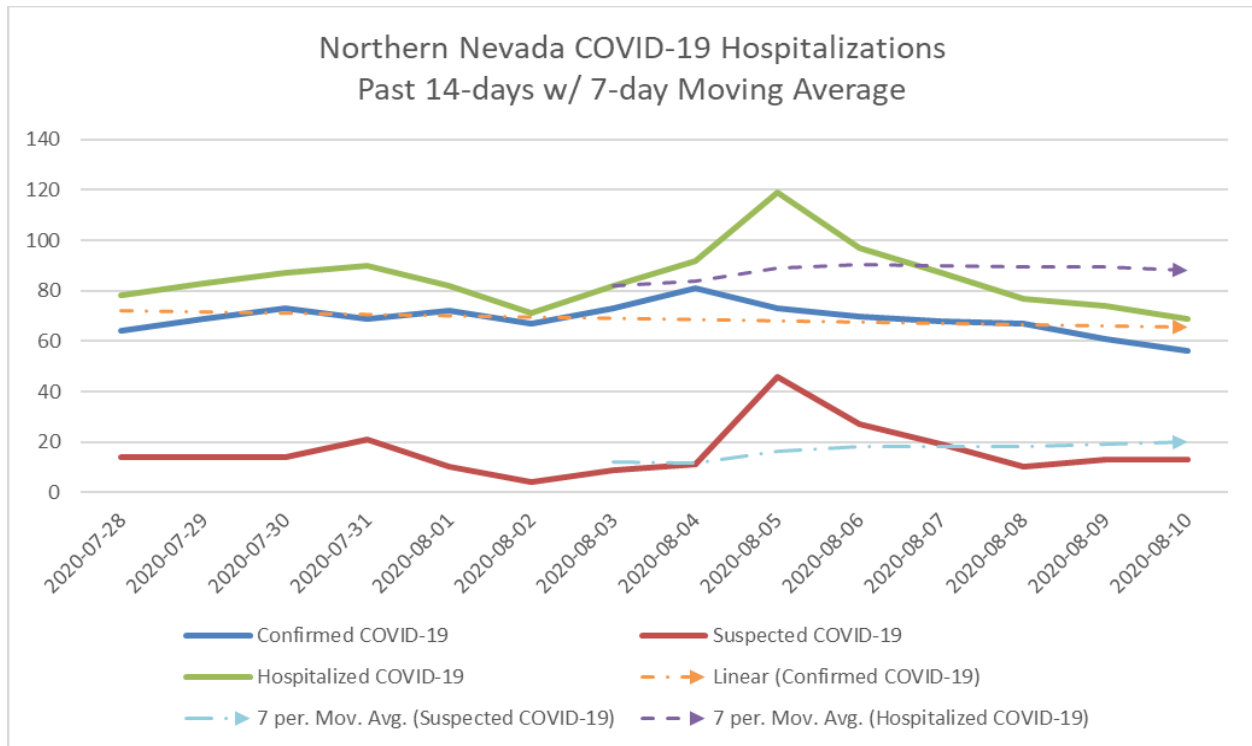


Clark County is experiencing a modest decrease in hospitalizations.

The relative burden on Clark County hospitals as a result of COVID-19 is 19% (hospitalized/ licensed bed count). Within the intensive care unit, the percentage of relative burden is 32% (hospitalized ICU/ licensed ICU beds).

Clark County hospital infrastructure is rated as being in fair condition with multiple hospitals having occupancy and intensive care occupancy rates in excess of 90%. Overall, the occupancy rates are 77% and 70% respectively and facilities continue to have the ability to surge, as necessary. Ventilator usage is at 50% of capacity; 23% of those ventilators are required by COVID patients.

Northern Nevada Data Set (Includes Washoe and Carson City Areas)



Northern Nevada has yet to experience a formed wave of patient hospitalizations but instead has remained within a range of 51- 119 hospitalized patients.

The relative burden on northern Nevada hospitals as a result of COVID-19 is 4% (hospitalized/ licensed bed count). Within the intensive care unit, the percentage of relative burden is 8% (hospitalized

ICU/ licensed ICU beds).

Northern Nevada hospital infrastructure is rated as being in good condition. Overall, the occupancy rates are 59% and 39% respectively for general hospital and intensive care units. Ventilator usage is at 10% of capacity; 3% of those ventilators are required by COVID patients.
