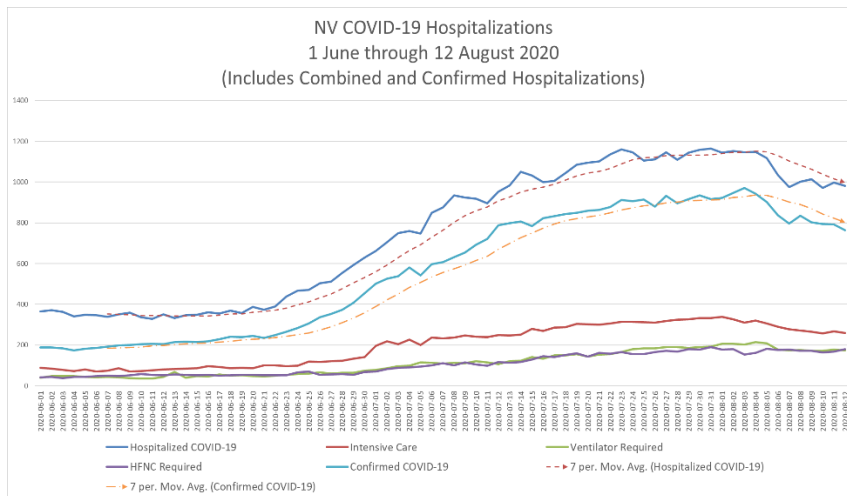
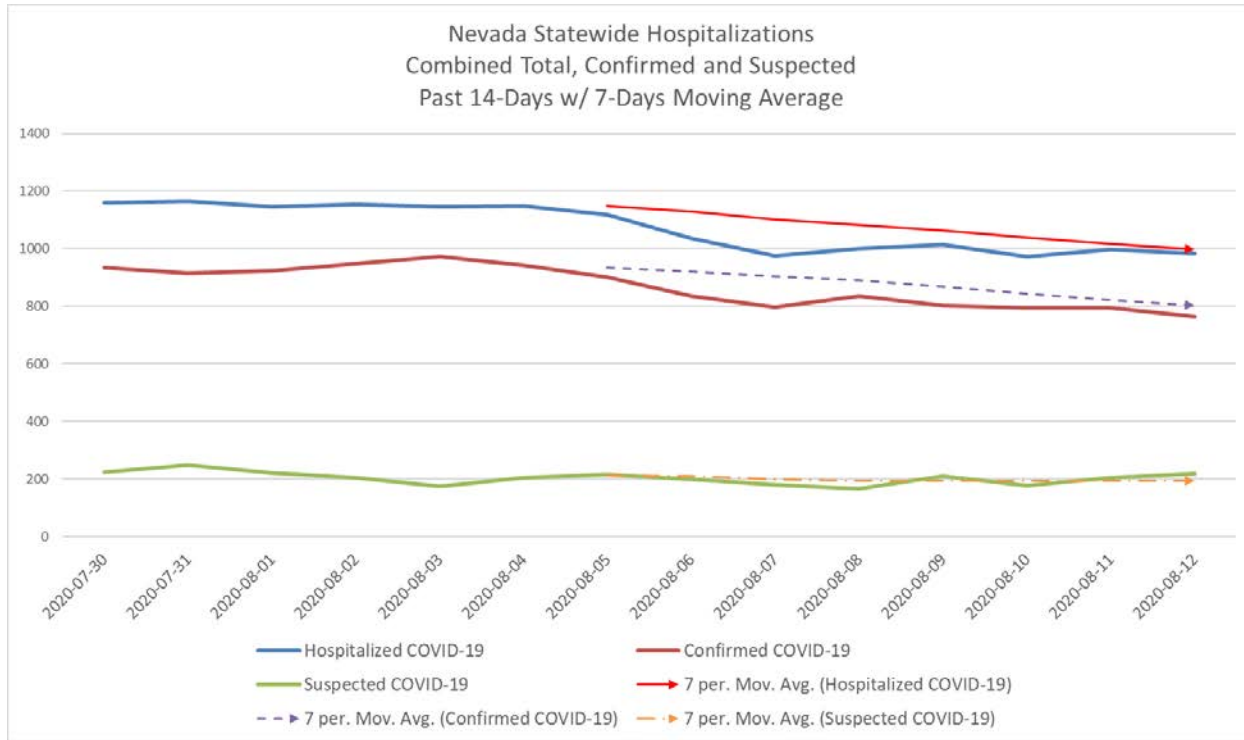


12 August 2020 Statewide Data Set



Nevada continues to appreciate a downward trend in COVID-19 hospitalizations (n=982).

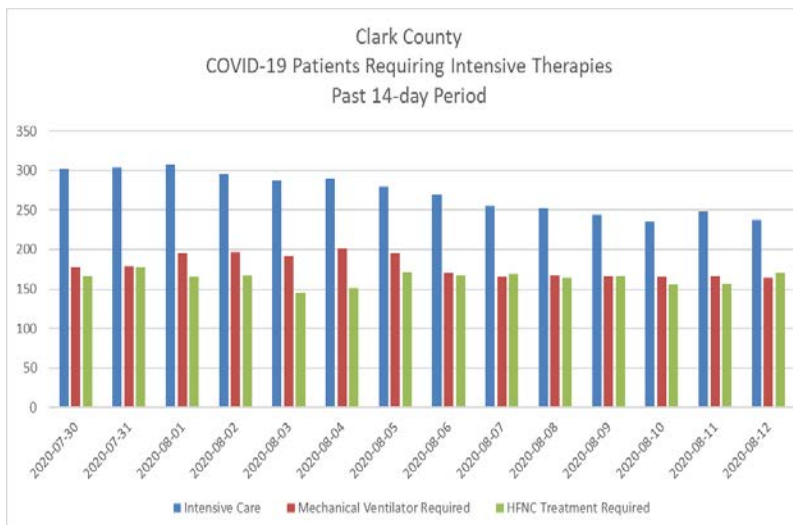
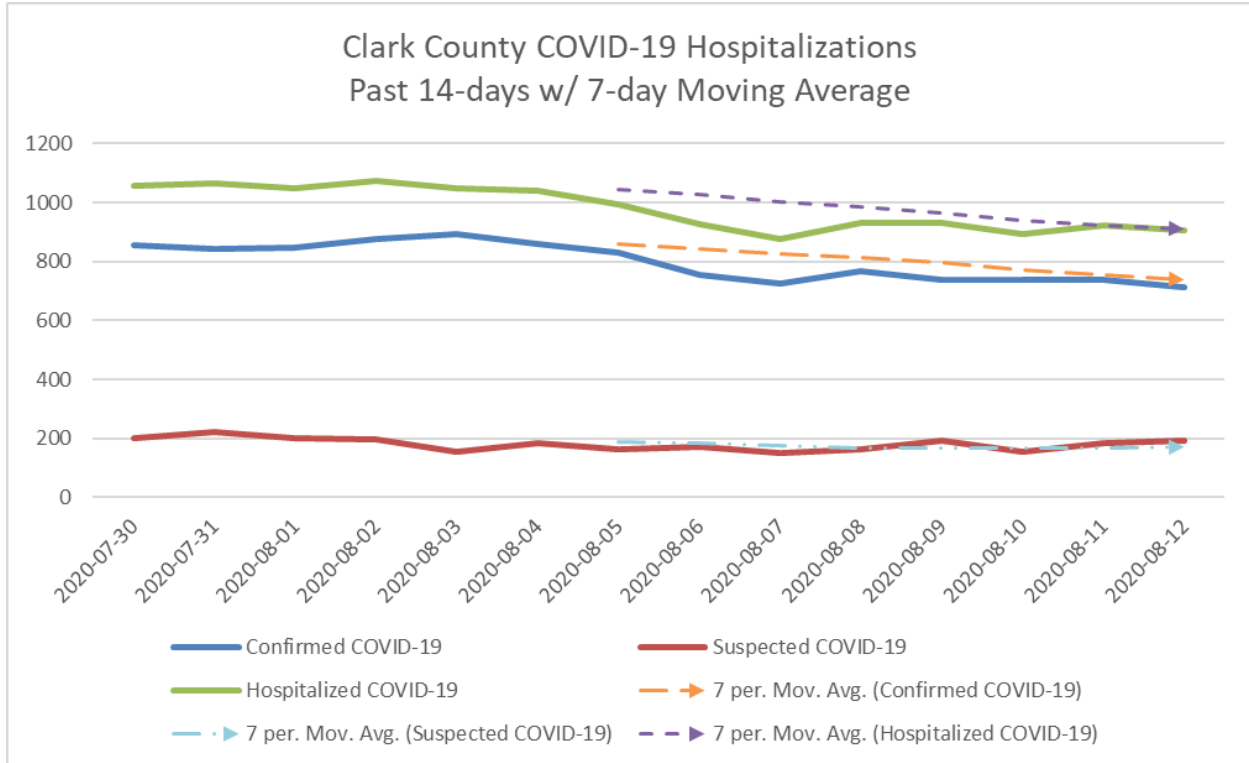
All-cause hospitalizations remain stable with occupancy rates of 70-80%.

On 12 Aug., the general hospital occupancy rate was 75%. Intensive care occupancy was 62% and ventilators in use

represented 39% of the statewide inventory.

Statewide the system remains in fair status with sufficient capacity however some individual facilities are experiencing occupancy rates at or near capacity in the intensive care units.

12 August – Clark County Data Set



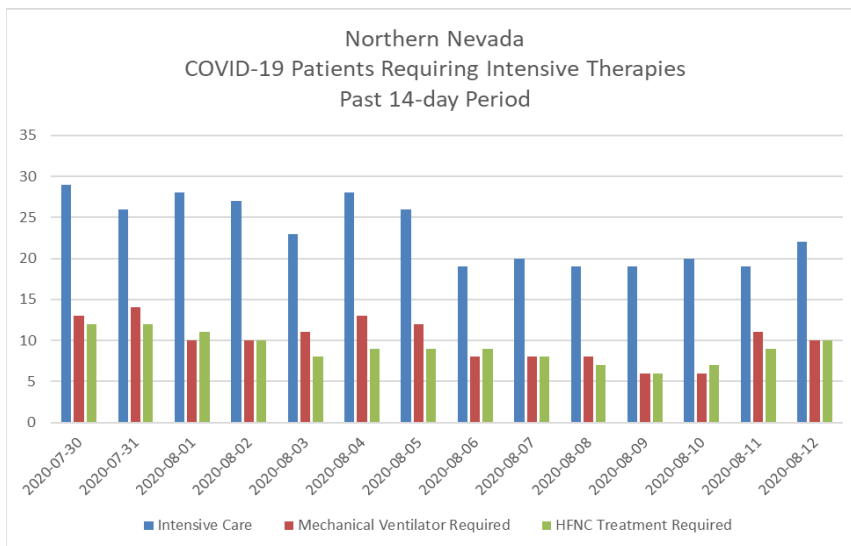
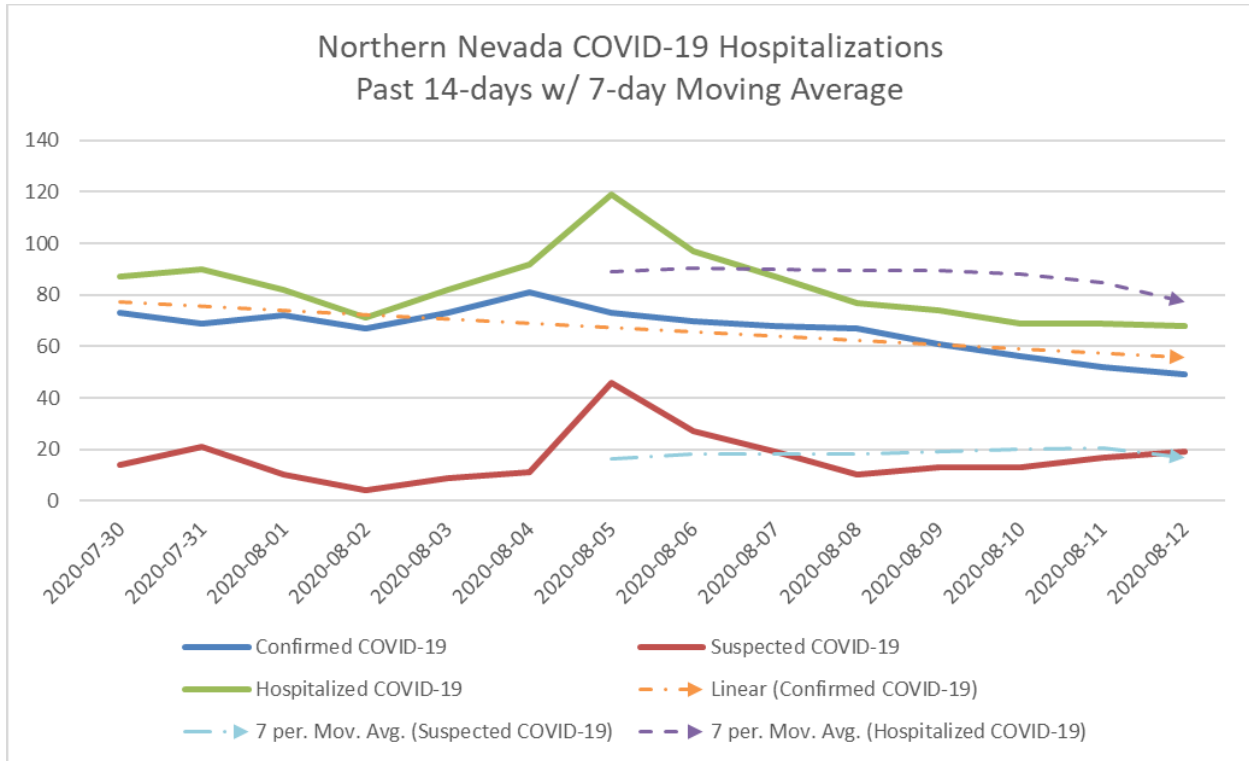
Clark County COVID-19 hospitalizations are trending downward (n=905).

Hospitalized COVID-19 patients represent 19% of the occupied licensed beds and 33% of occupied licensed ICU beds in the county.

COVID-19 patients account for 47% of all patients who require mechanical ventilation and are utilizing 22% of the ventilators in the Clark County hospitals' inventory.

Several hospitals in the region continue to experience ICU saturation with occupancy rates above 90% however, the number of effected facilities appears to be on the decline. Additionally, several facilities continue to indicate ICU staffing shortages. The hospital infrastructure in Clark County remains in fair condition.

12 August – Northern Nevada Data Set



Northern Nevada COVID-19 hospitalizations are declining following a peak on 5 Aug. of 119 patients. The number of hospitalized COVID-19 patients on 12 Aug. was 68.

The number of COVID-19 patients requiring intensive care has remained within a general range of 20-30 patients over the course of the last 14-days. Patients needing mechanical ventilation is about half of those in the intensive care unit.

COVID-19 patients account for 4% of licensed hospital beds occupancy, 7% of licensed ICU bed occupancy and are utilizing 4% of available ventilator inventory.

The healthcare infrastructure within the northern Nevada region remains good.
