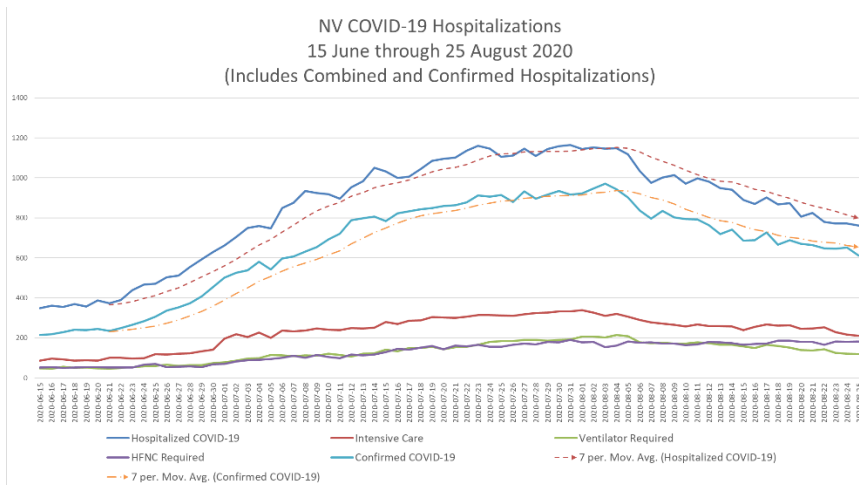
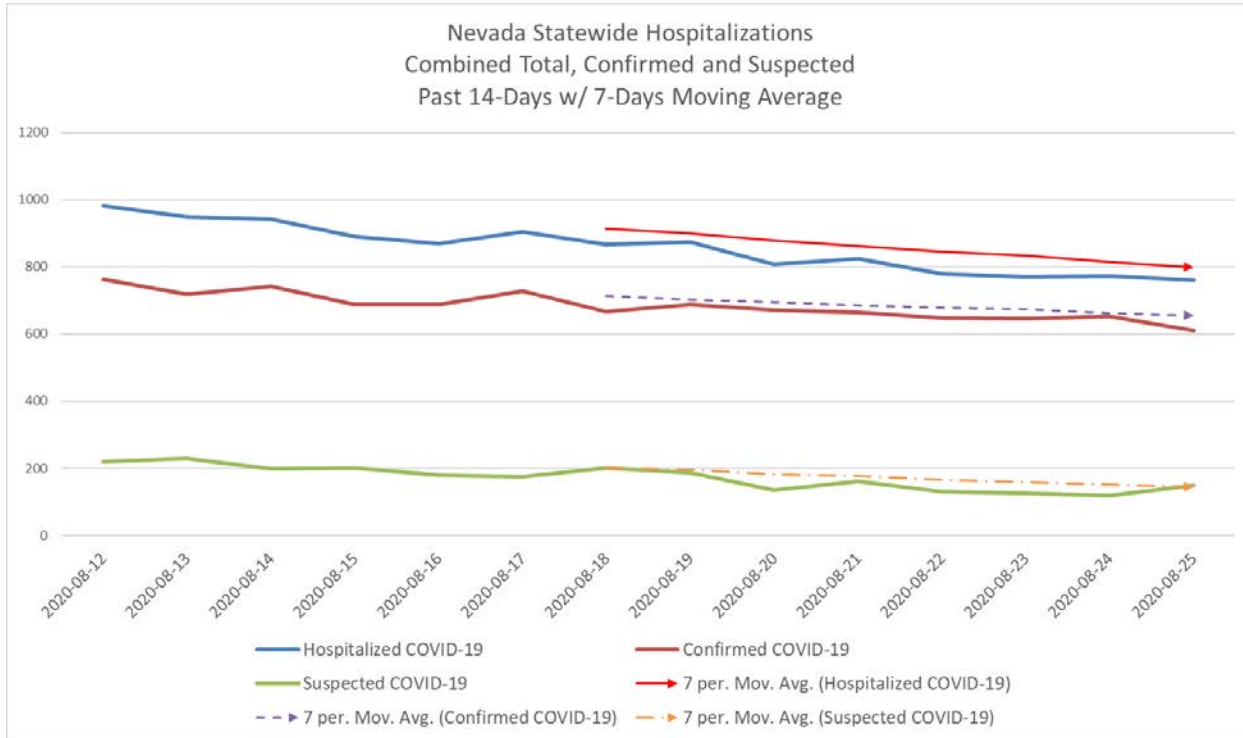


25 August 2020 Statewide Data Set



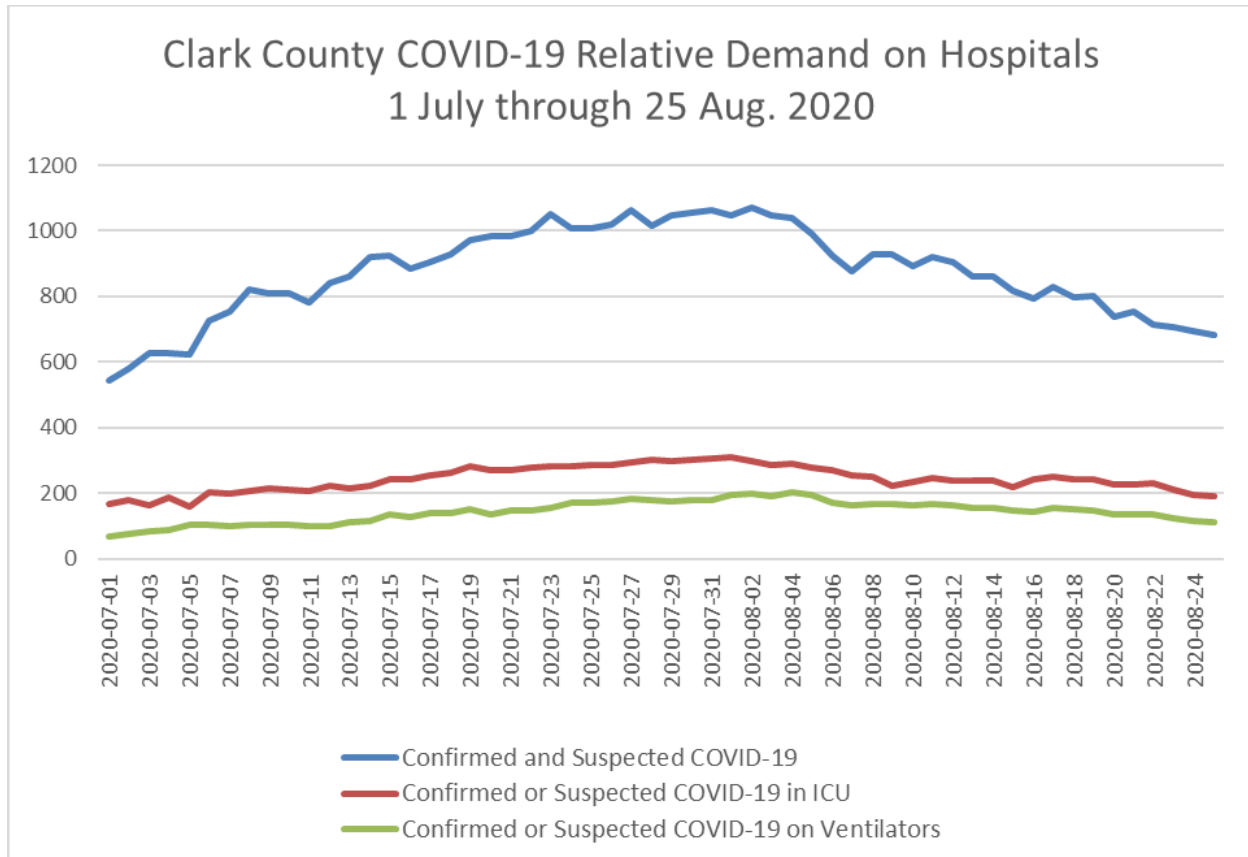
Nevada's healthcare infrastructure continues to appreciate a decline in COVID-19 demand and currently is not being significantly stressed by the virus.

The healthcare system is hypothesizing and preparing for COVID-19 to be circulating for months to come, including during the up coming flu season. COVID-19 may become endemic similarly to

other once novel viruses (HIV, West Nile, etc.).

Hospital planning is now focusing on restructuring policies and procedures, and to incorporate this virus into the healthcare workflow for the foreseeable future vs. the emergency and crisis response phase that hospitals found themselves in just a few months ago.

Clark County Data Set

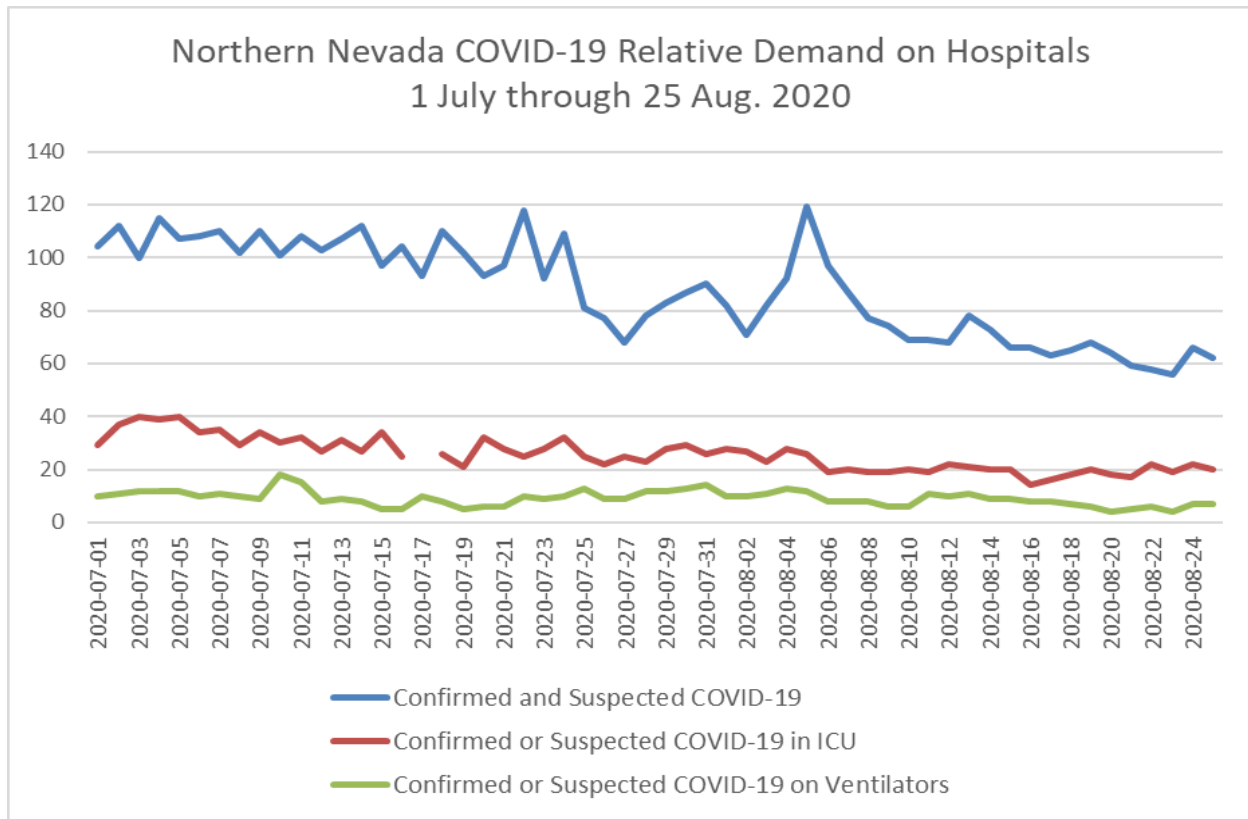


Relative demand of COVID-19 on the Clark County healthcare infrastructure continues to decline. The number of confirmed and suspected hospitalized cases is 684. Confirmed and suspected hospitalized cases was 796 on 18 Aug. by comparison and 544 on 1 July.

COVID-19 patients account for 18% of all hospitalized patients (21% on 18 Aug.) and 38% of all patients requiring intensive care (45% 18 Aug.). COVID-19 patients are using 15% of the County's ventilator capacity (21% 18 Aug.).

The healthcare infrastructure within Clark County is in fair condition with sufficient excess capacity and capability. A few facilities are experiencing greater than normal occupancy in the general hospital and intensive care units, but this too is decreasing.

Northern Nevada Data Set



Relative demand of COVID-19 on the Northern Nevada healthcare infrastructure continues to slowly decline. The number of confirmed and suspected hospitalized cases is 62. Confirmed and suspected hospitalized cases was 65 on 18 Aug. by comparison and 104 on 1 July.

COVID-19 patients account for 6% of all hospitalized patients (6% on 18 Aug.) and 17% of all patients requiring intensive care (18% 18 Aug.). COVID-19 patients are using 3% of the County's ventilator capacity (3% 18 Aug).

The healthcare infrastructure within Northern Nevada is in good condition with sufficient excess capacity and capability. COVID-19 is not currently placing any significant strain on hospitals within the region.
