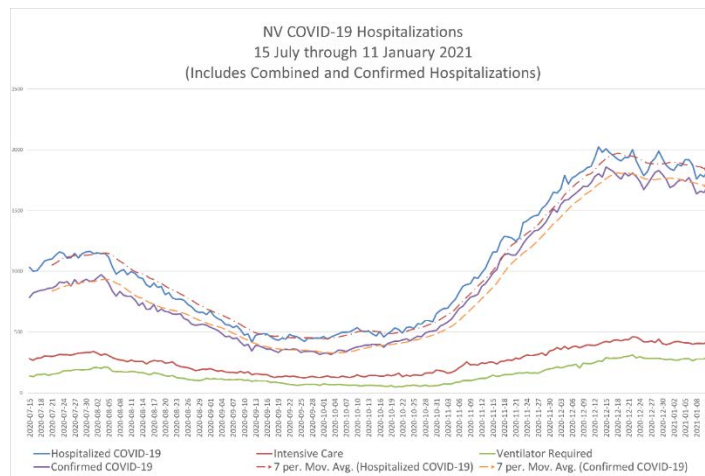
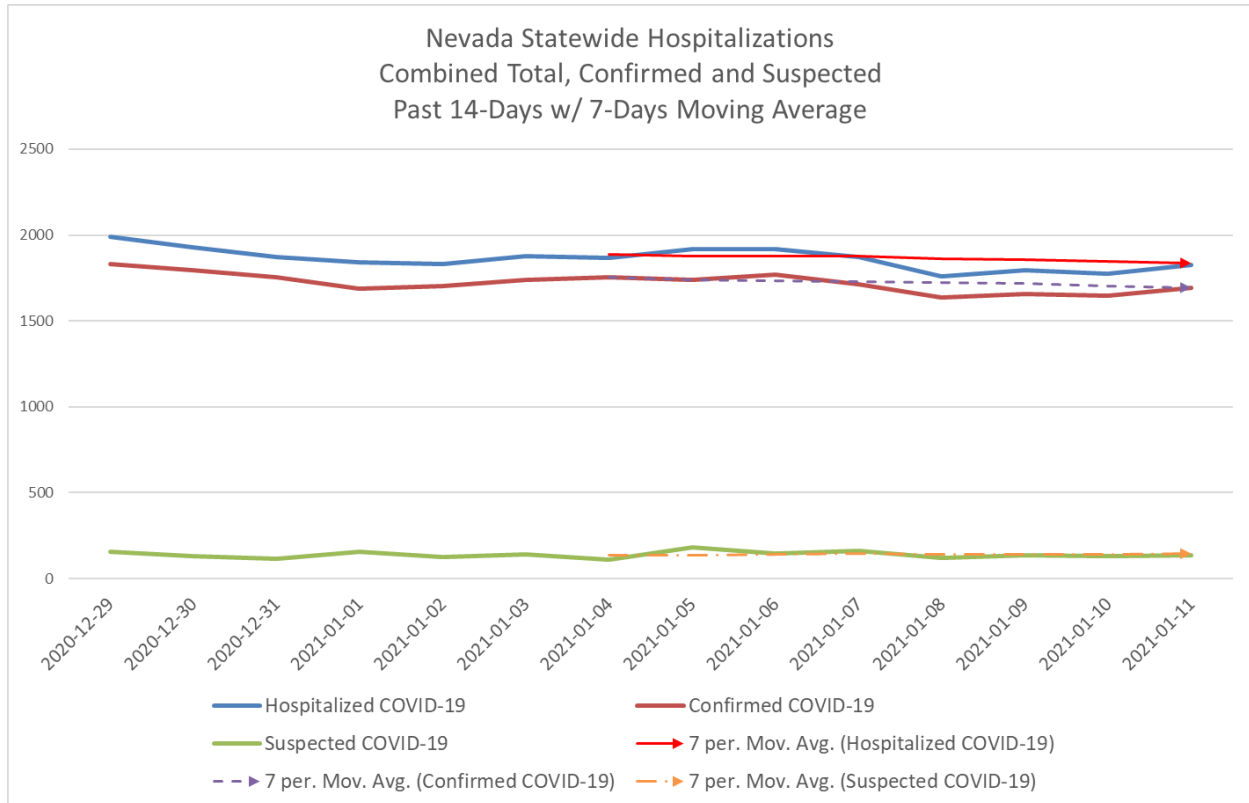


## 11 January 2021 Statewide Data Set



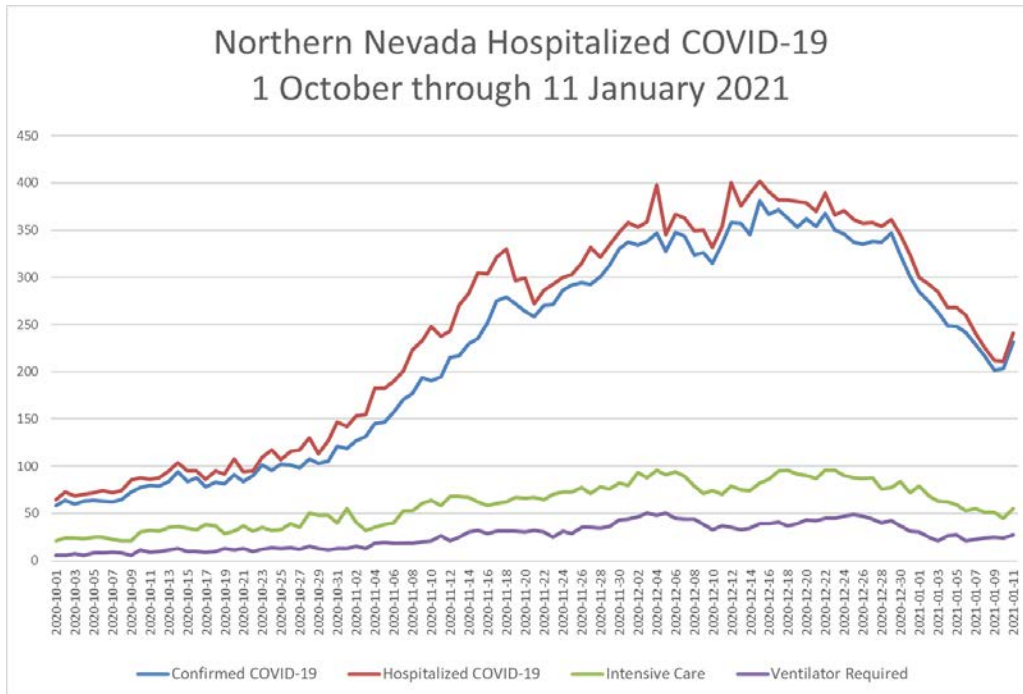
The use of nonpharmaceutical interventions, such as the statewide “pause” appear to have successfully arrested the increasing trajectory of hospitalizations. However, due to the holiday season and other socialization causes, these efforts have experienced significant counterpressures. The full effects of the holiday season and other gatherings may not be fully realized for another several weeks.

Regionally, some individual facilities are still feeling significant strain from elevated hospital admissions and ICU admissions. This strain is being experienced predominately in the southern part of the state.

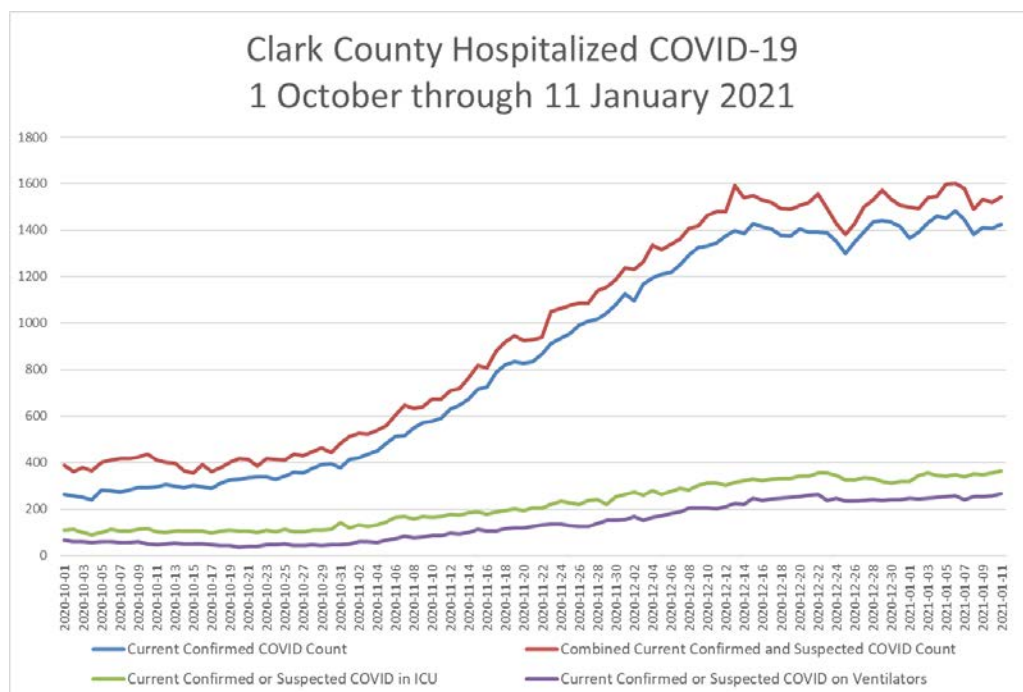
Hospitals are reporting that employees have begun receiving the second dose of the vaccine regimen. PPE, supplies, and equipment are generally in good condition throughout the state. Multiple facilities are reporting staffing challenges.

Currently, one-third of all people hospitalized in Nevada have COVID-19. Forty percent of all ICU beds are filled with COVID-19 patients and twenty-five percent of all ventilators in use are for COVID-19 patients.
