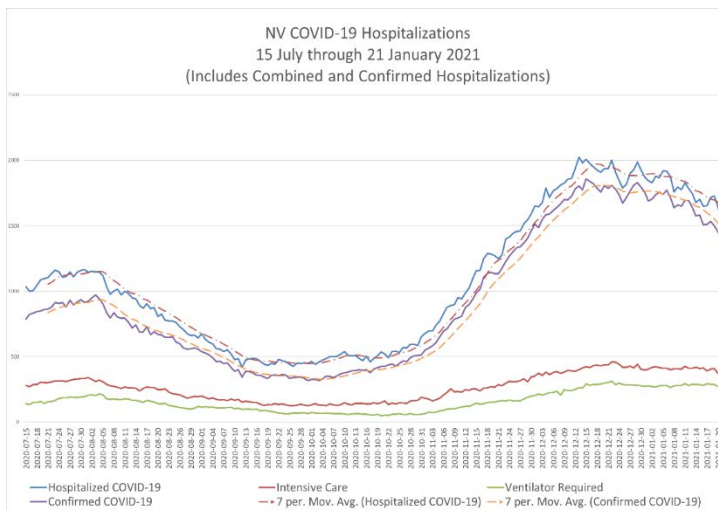
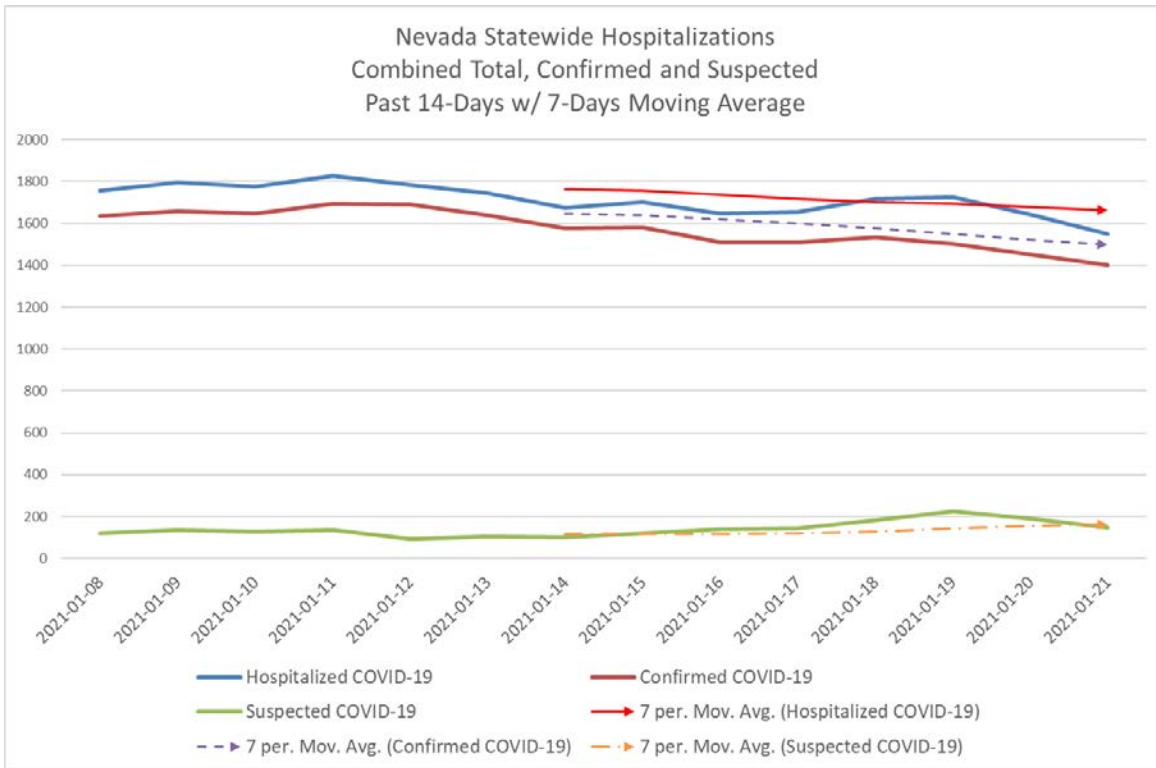

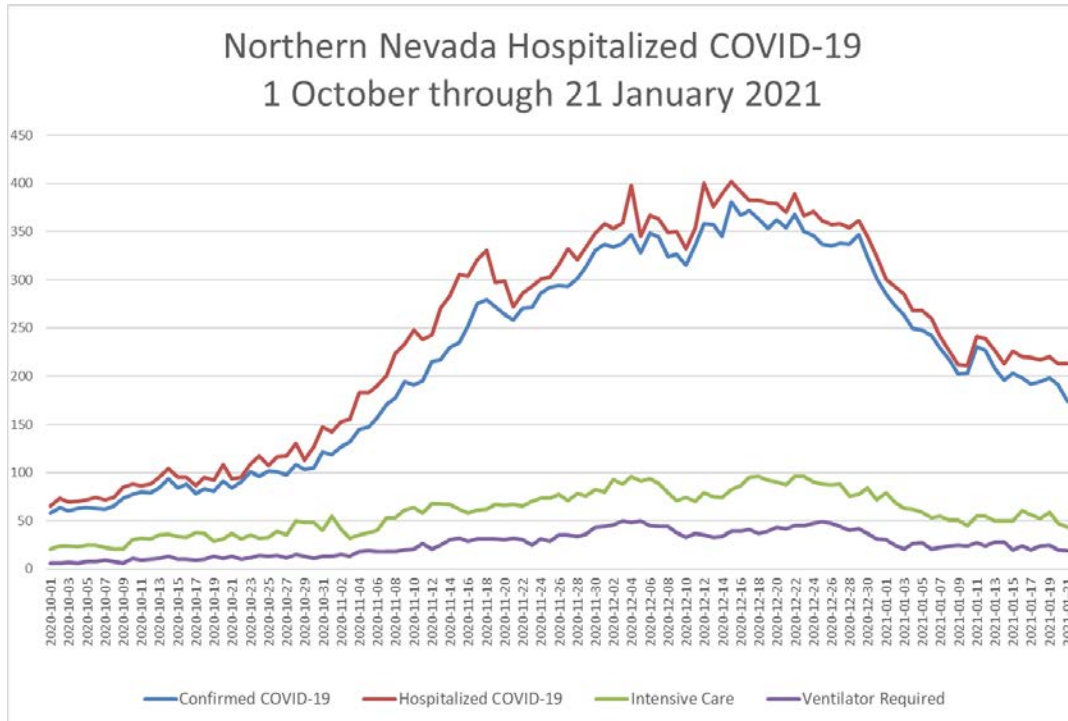
Nevada enters the weekend with a declining trajectory of confirmed COVID-19 cases. If this trend continues, hospitalized case counts should be below the 500 mark by late February.

All cause intensive care use remains elevated within the southern region. Occupancy rates at several facilities are at near capacity, while the overall occupancy rate is at 77%. (41% COVID).

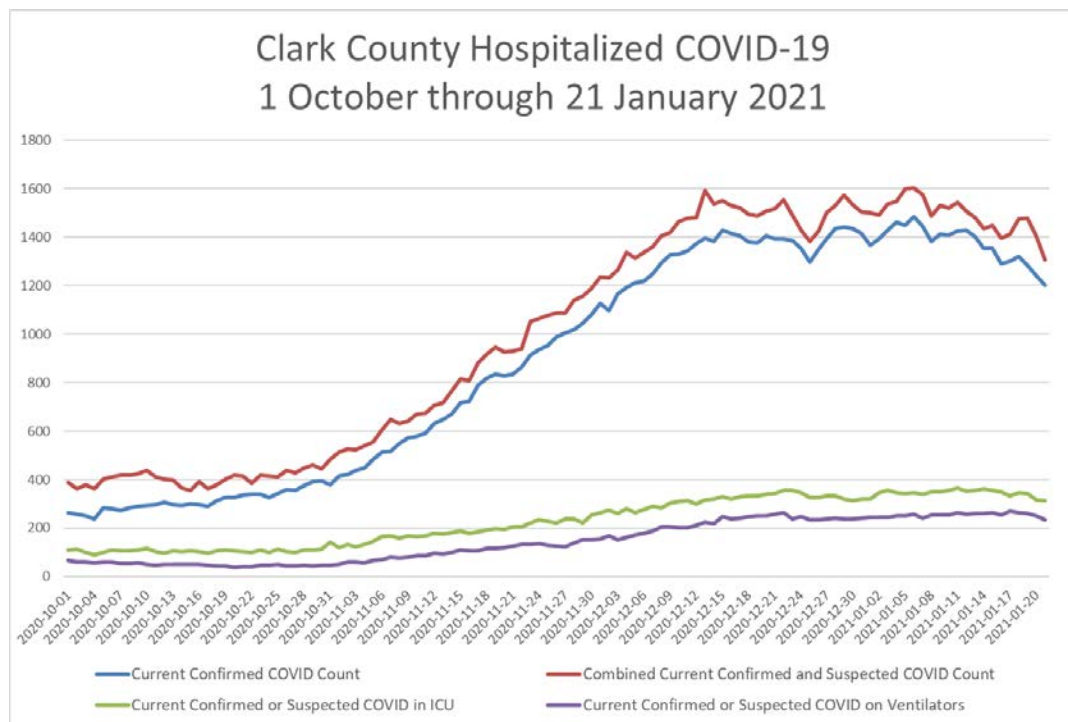
In the northern region, the healthcare system is demonstrating signs of normalization. Northern hospitals report having capacity, including within the ICU. No facilities are reporting staffing shortages and some hospitals have begun demobilizing triage tents.

Yesterday, the national strategy for COVID-19 response was released (<https://www.whitehouse.gov/wp-content/uploads/2021/01/National-Strategy-for-the-COVID-19-Response-and-Pandemic-Preparedness.pdf>). This strategy calls for changes in various levels of data reporting, most of which the NHA is already meeting, including near real-time data display, which NHA has achieved with our new Healthcare Infrastructure Surveillance System.

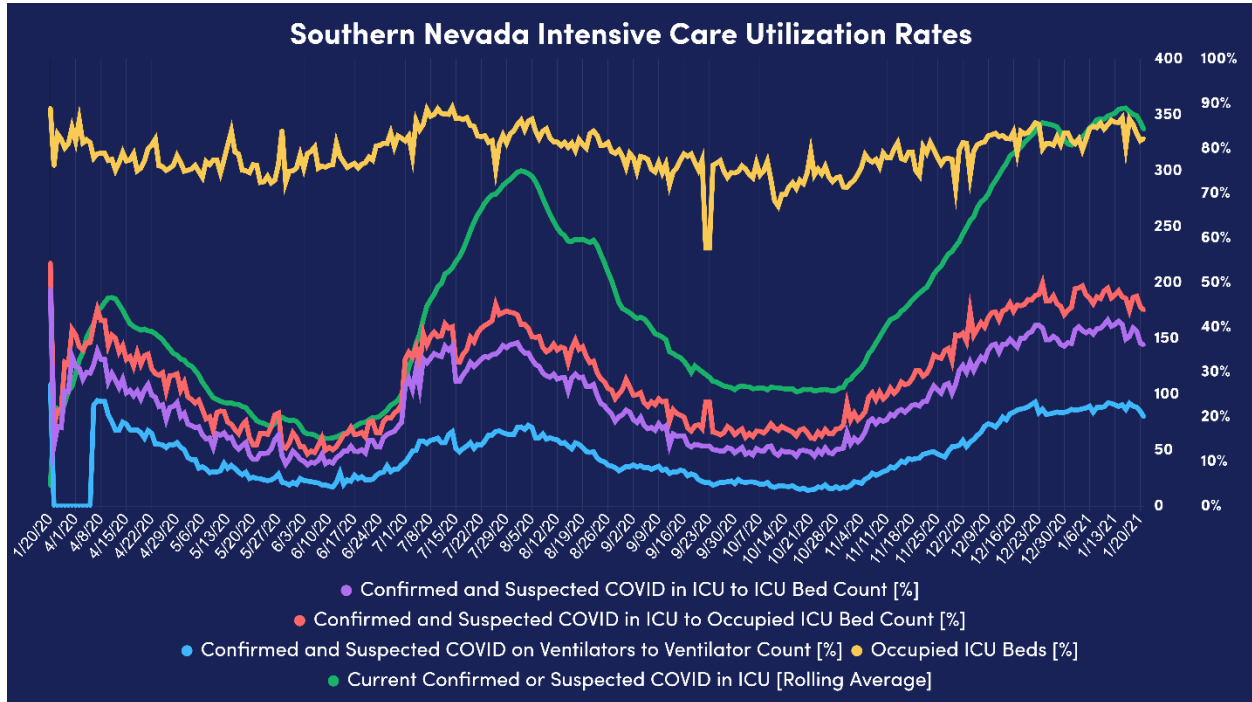
Northern Nevada Data Set
