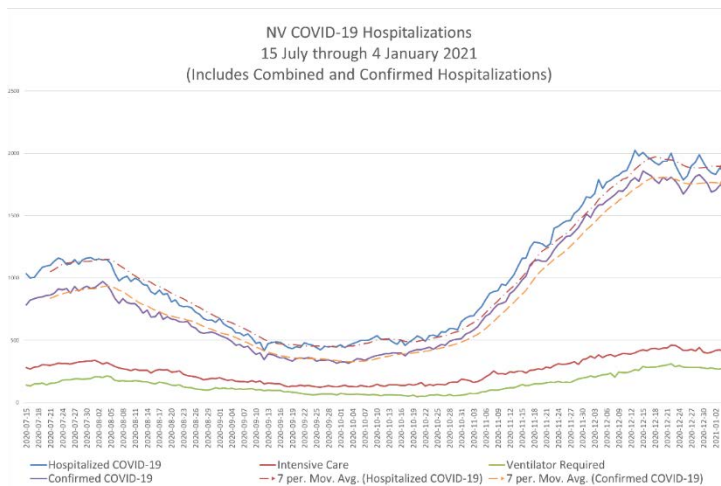
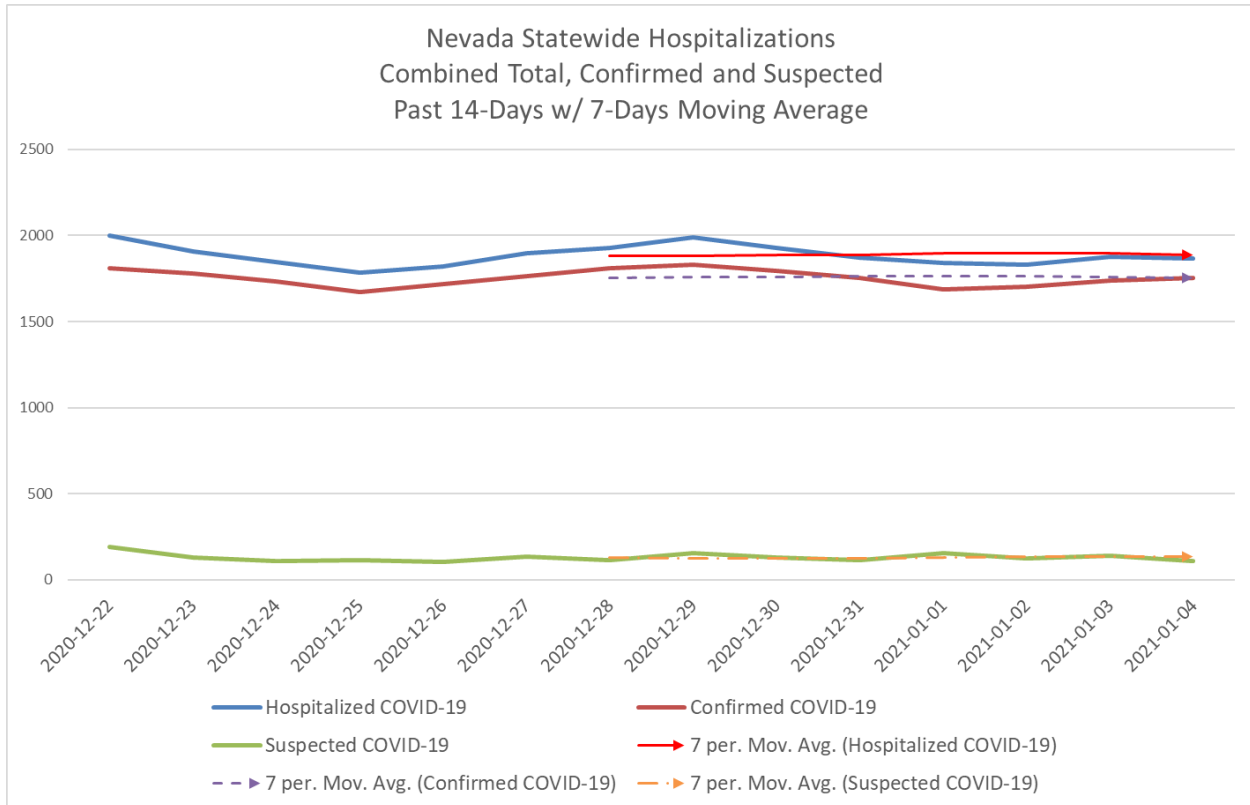


January 4, 2021 Statewide Data Set



Nevada's hospitalized COVID-19 count appears to be stabilizing with confirmed case counts remaining in the 1,700- 1,800 range for the last few weeks. The northern region is experiencing precipitous declines in hospitalizations while the southern region is remaining flat.

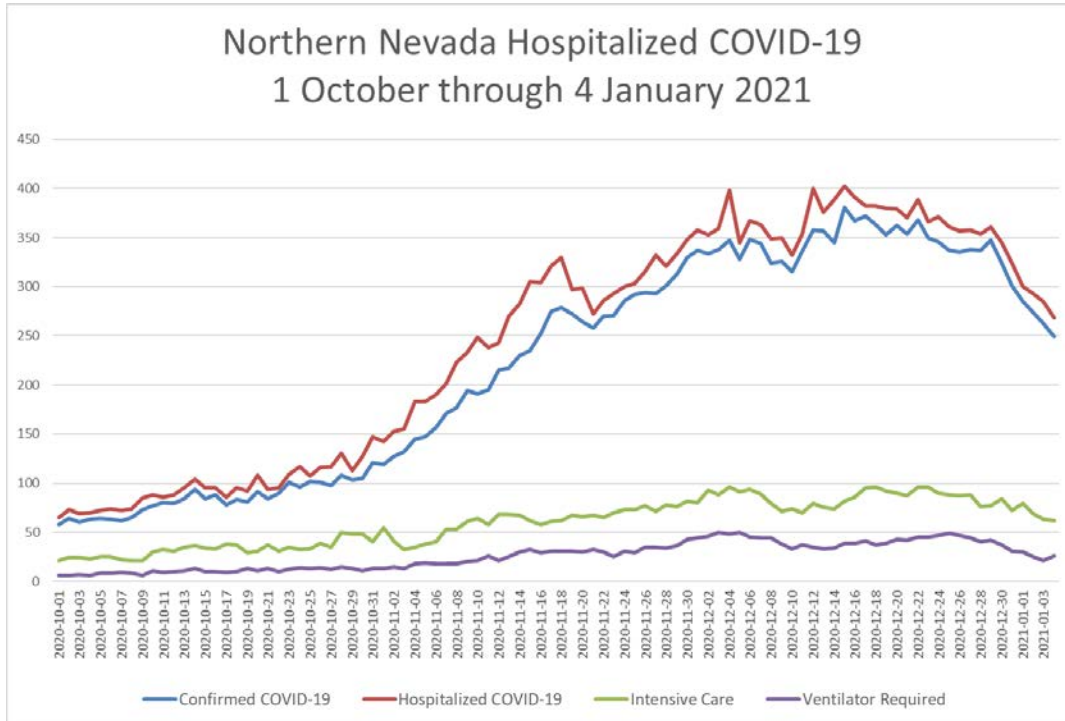
Hospitals continue to report staffing shortages throughout the state. Supplies, equipment, and pharmaceuticals remain in a good status.

The relative demand being placed on hospitals by COVID-19 is currently 34.4%. In the intensive care unit (ICU), 55.9% of all ICU level patients have COVID-19 or 40% of all licensed ICU beds are occupied by a patient who has

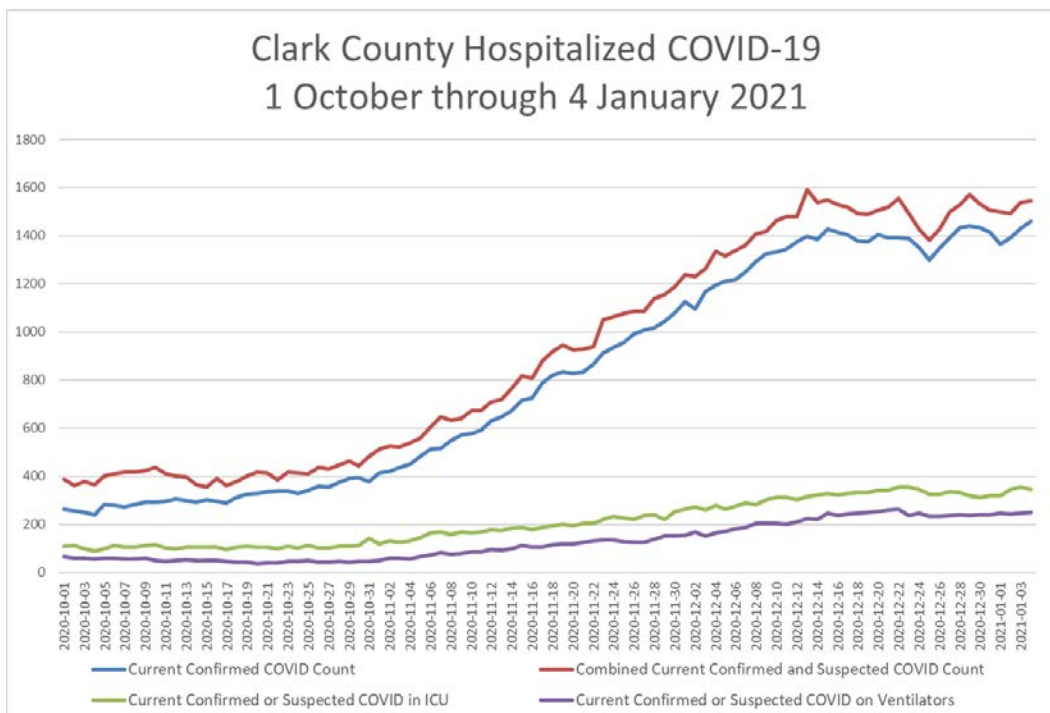
COVID.

According to the CDC (<https://covid.cdc.gov/covid-data-tracker/#vaccinations>) Nevada has received more than 141,500 vaccine doses and administered only 34,454. Hospitals meanwhile continue to vaccinate their workforce and in some cases first responders as well.

Northern Nevada Data Set



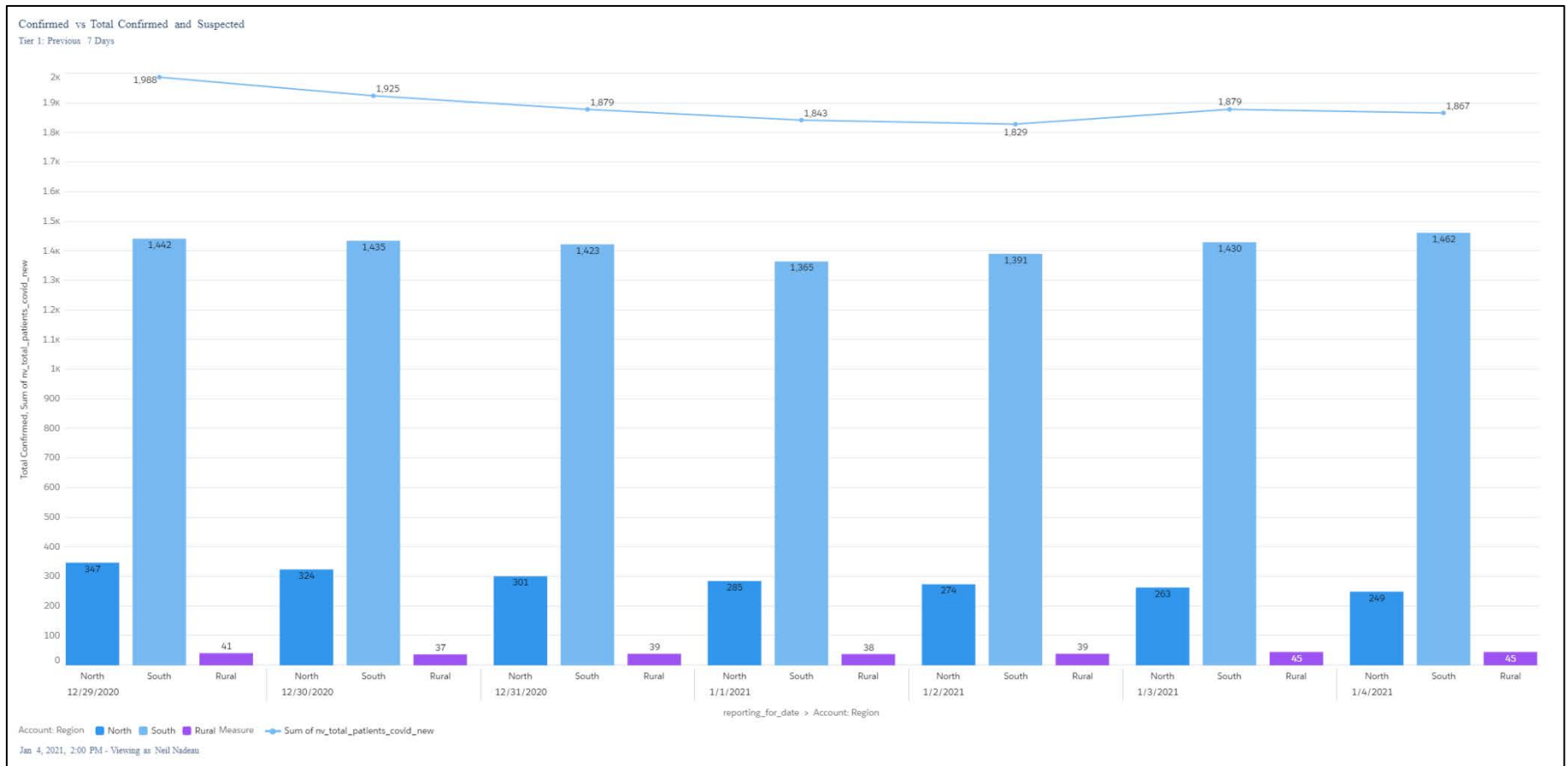
