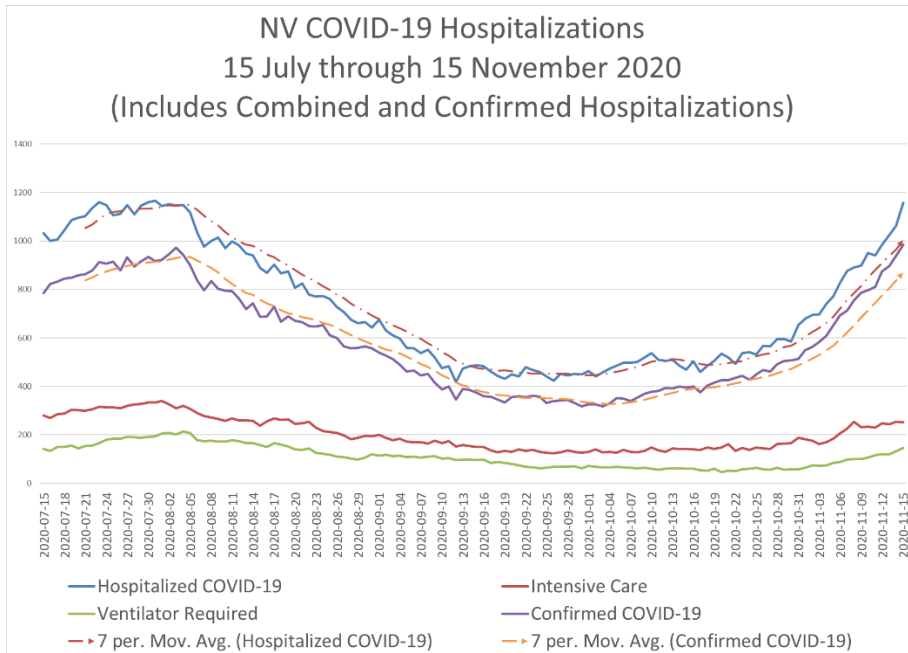
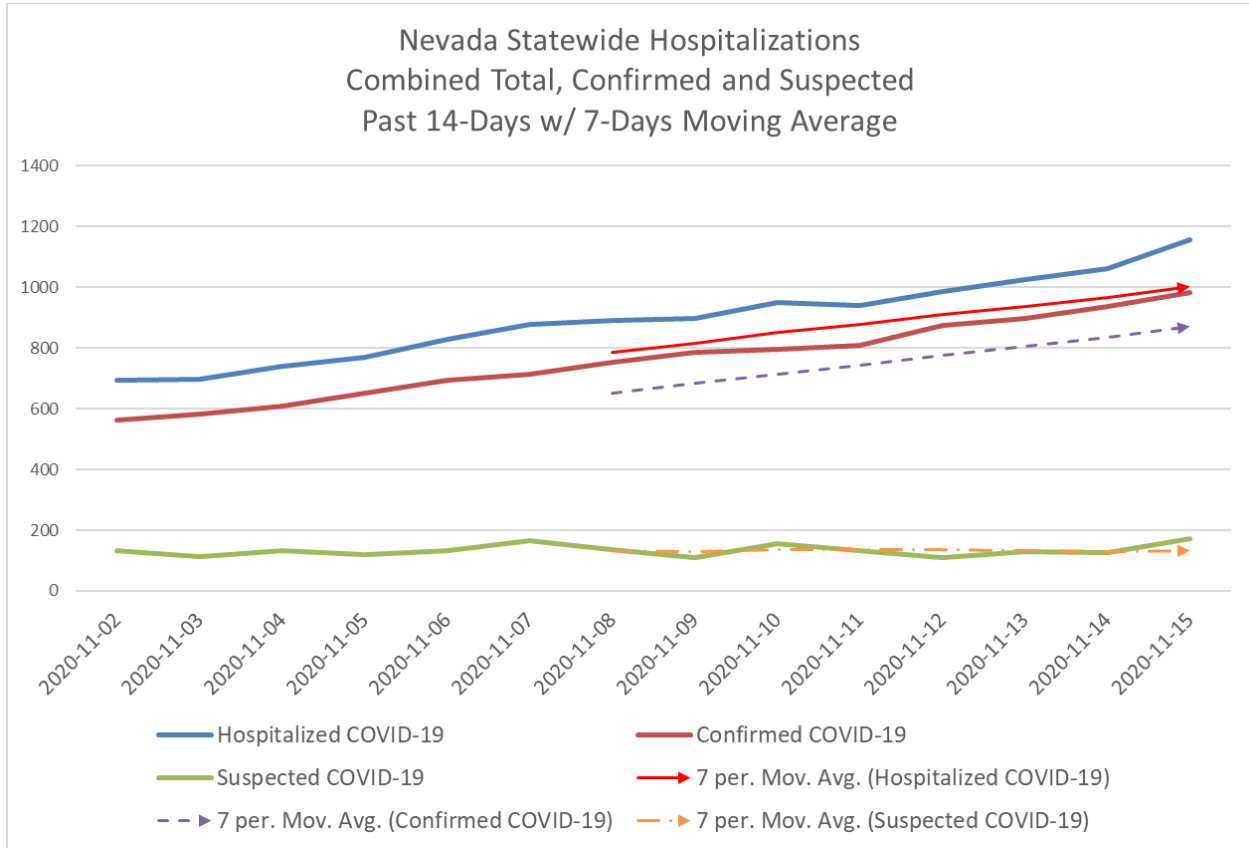


## 15 November 2020 Statewide Data Set

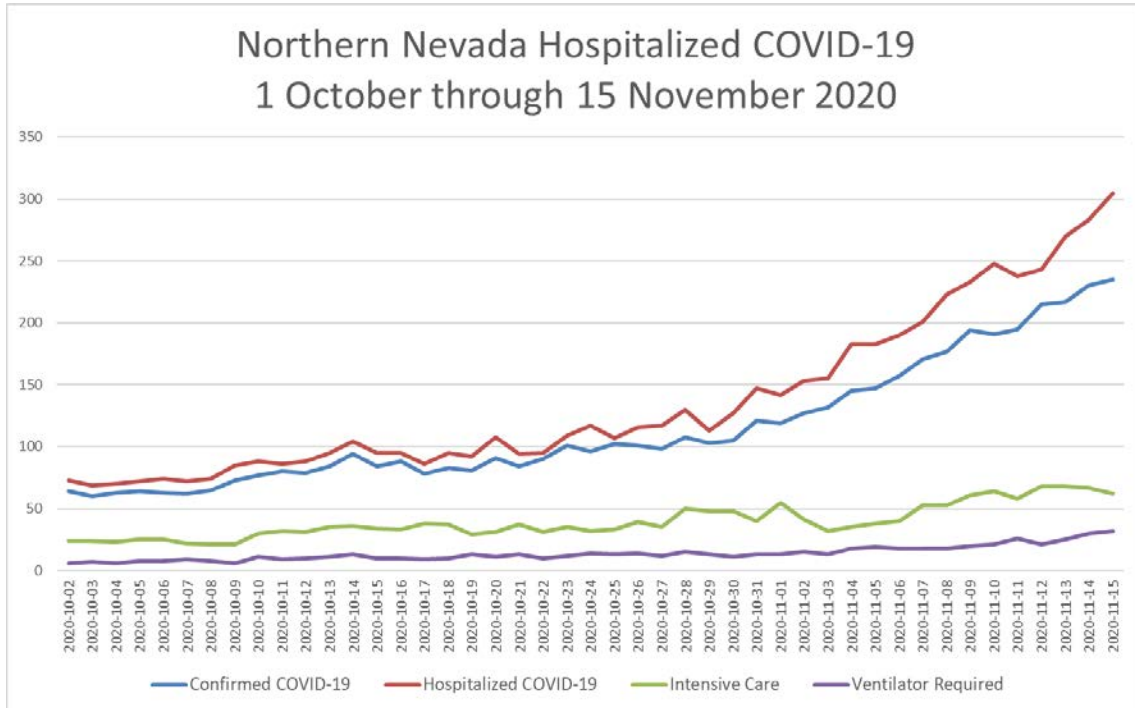


COVID-19 hospitalizations continue to climb with 1,157 people hospitalized with the virus, nearing the high of 1,165 recorded on July 31, 2020.

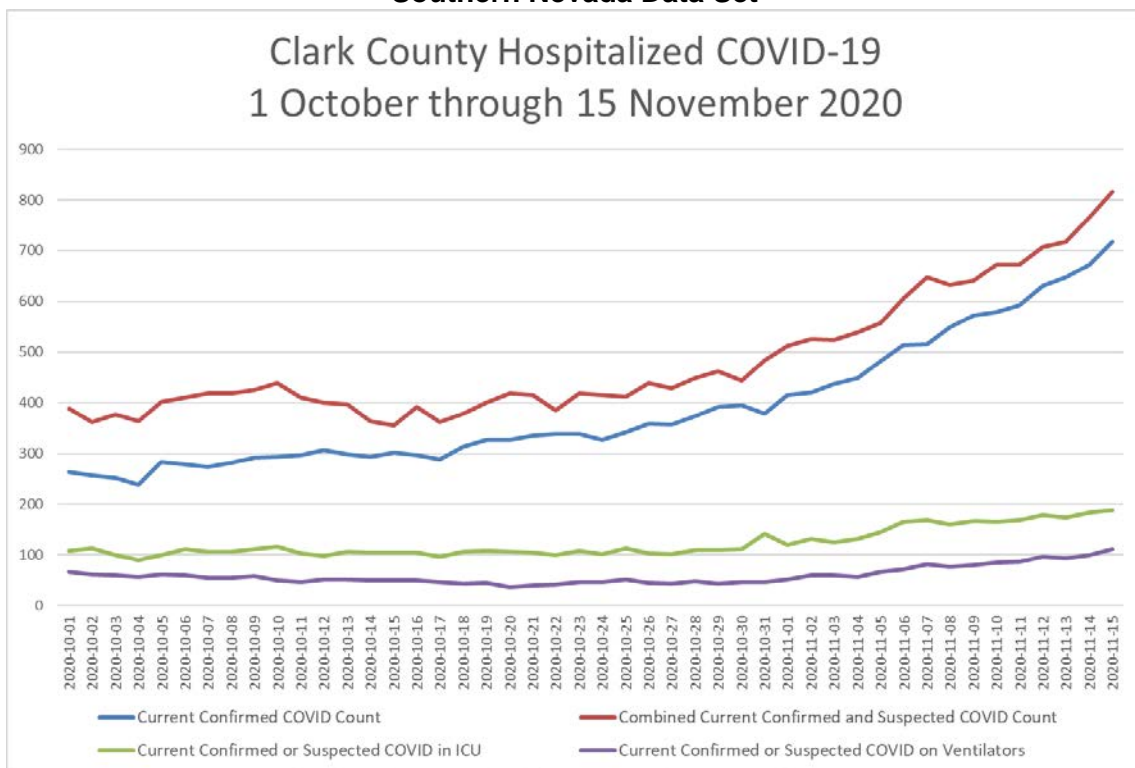
Hospitals throughout the state are adding bed capacity and managing throughput variables, such as staffing patterns to accommodate the increases in patient census.

## Northern Nevada Data Set



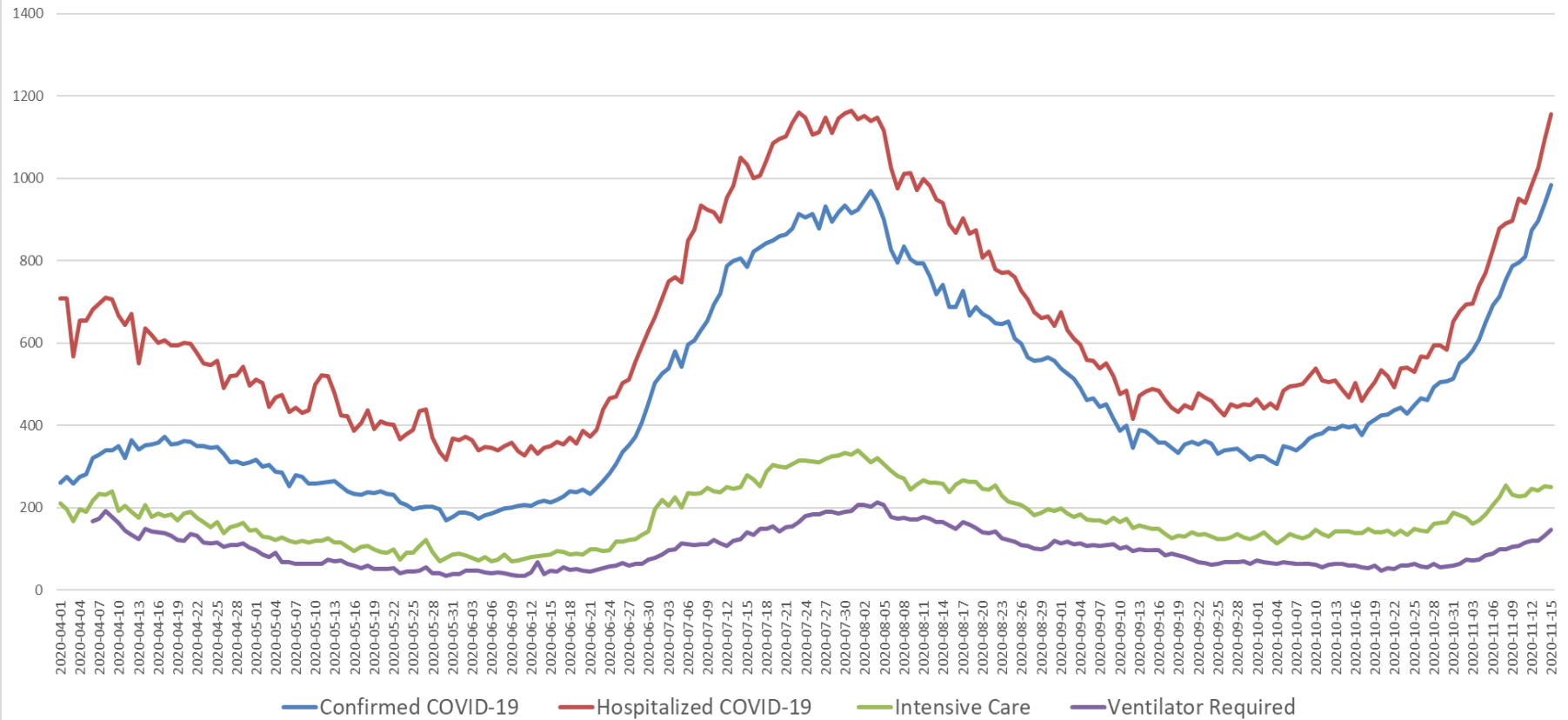
## Southern Nevada Data Set
