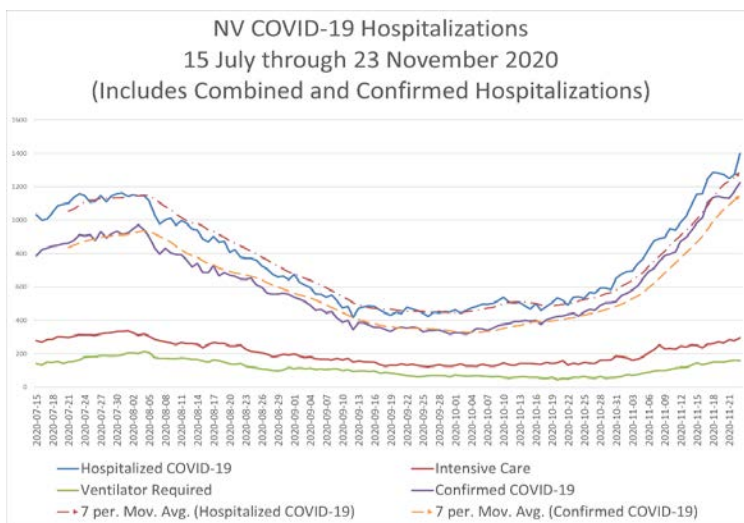
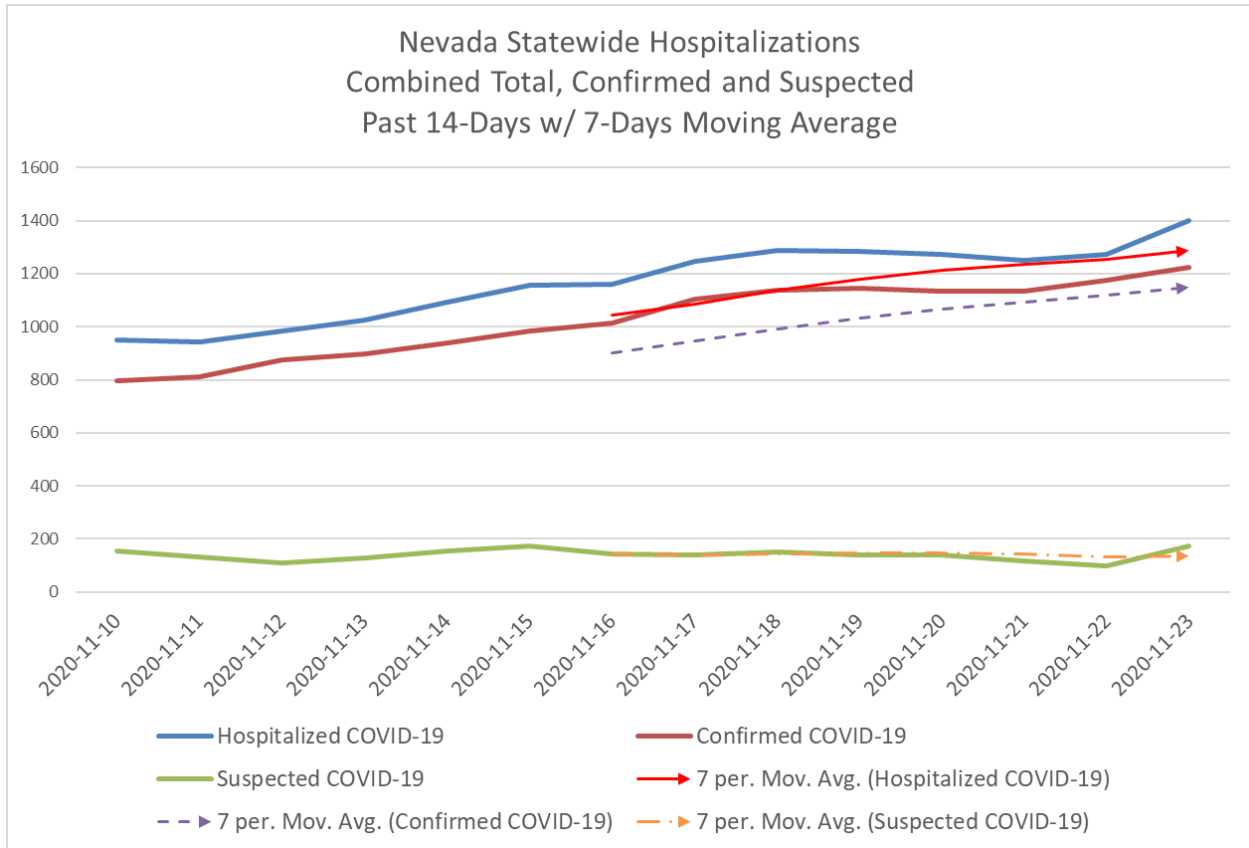

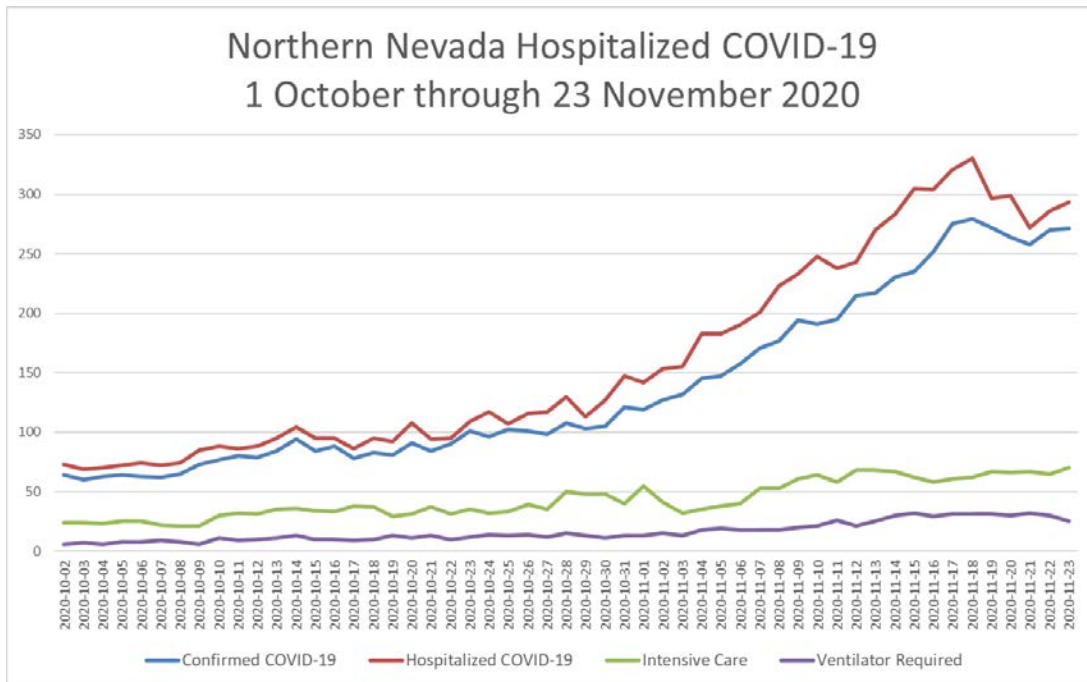
Increases in hospitalizations continue throughout Nevada. Northern Nevada had been exhibiting a slowing of hospital admissions however, cases began increasing over the past weekend reversing this trajectory.

Rural Nevada is reportedly experiencing increased positivity rates. This has not translated, to date, into significant case counts of serious disease requiring hospitalizations.

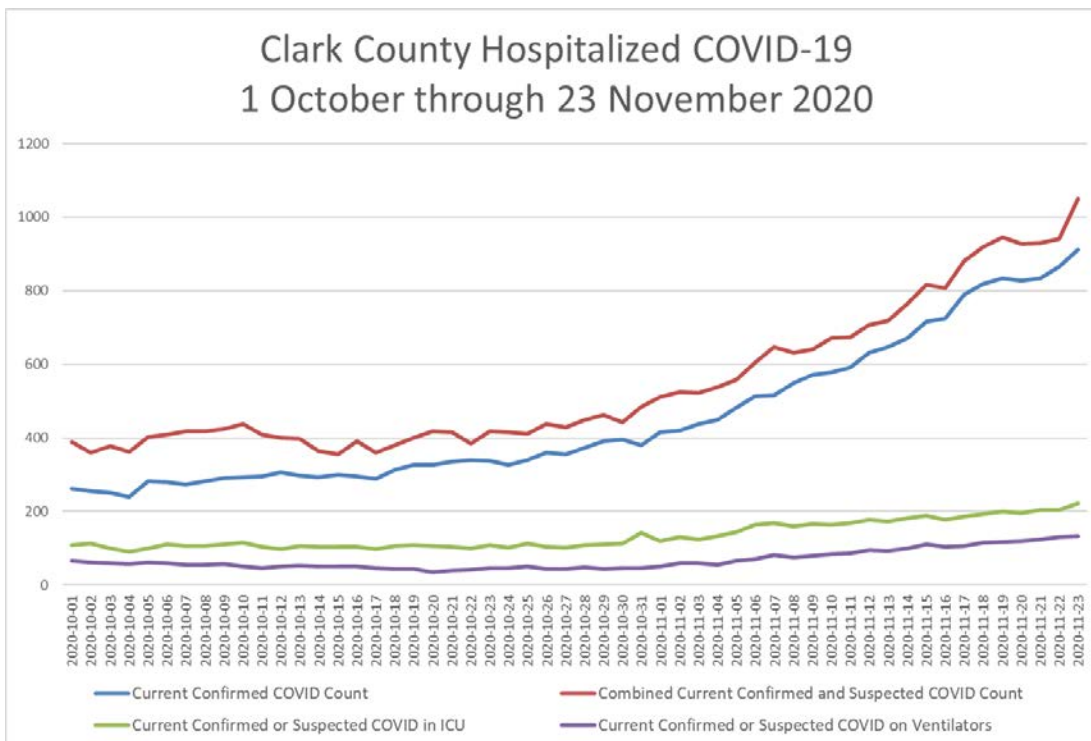
Some rural counties which have been flagged for elevated disease transmission such as Churchill, Douglas, Elko and Nye are experiencing stress on their hospital systems

as a result of the small size of the hospital facility when compared with the relative burden of COVID-19 patients. Other rural counties such as Lander, Lincoln, and Lyon are not experiencing significant hospital demand either with admissions or ED visits.

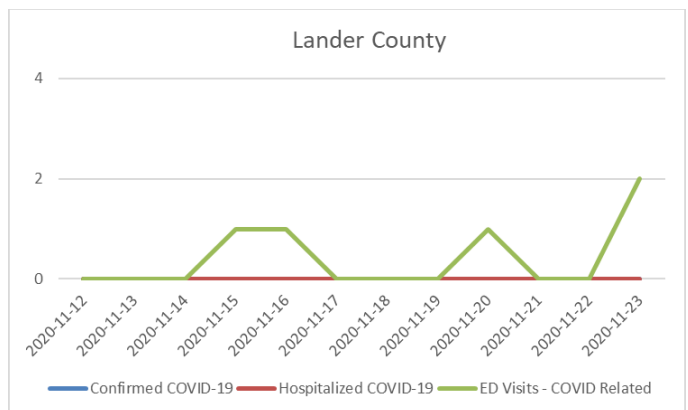
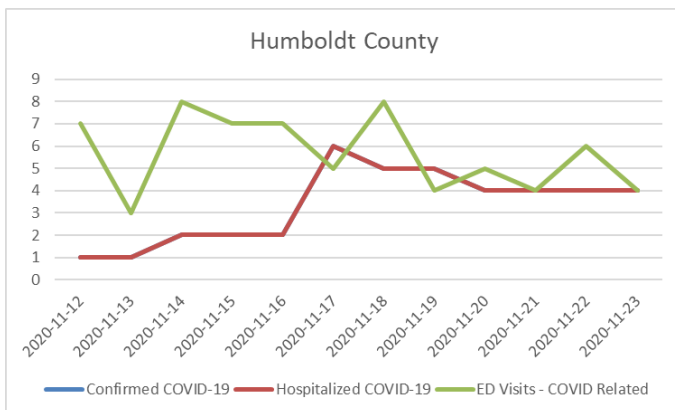
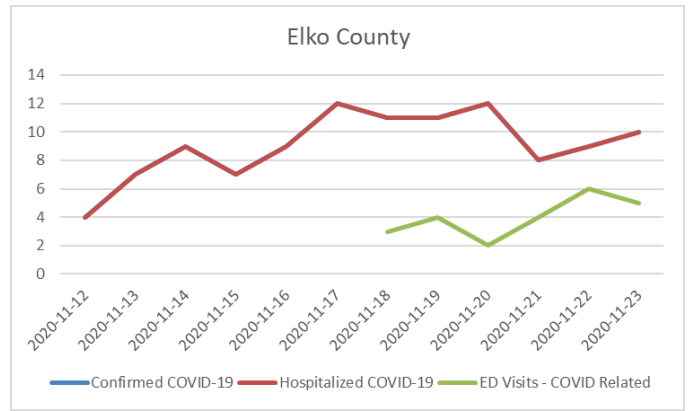
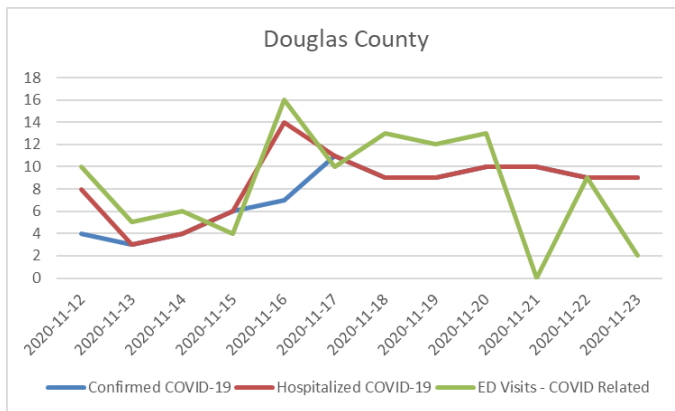
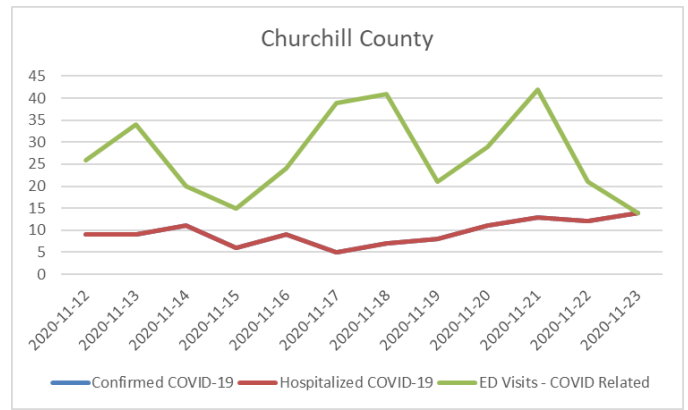
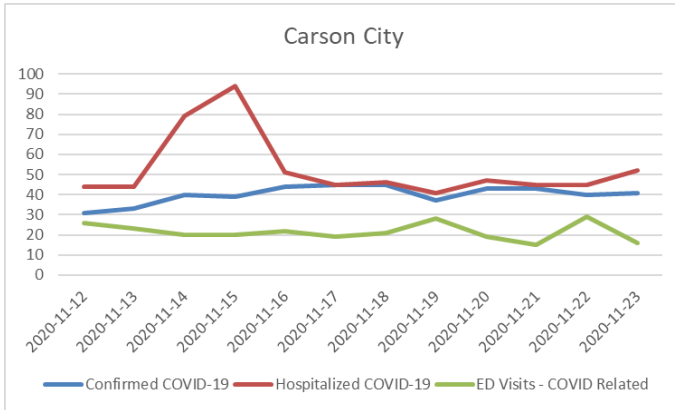

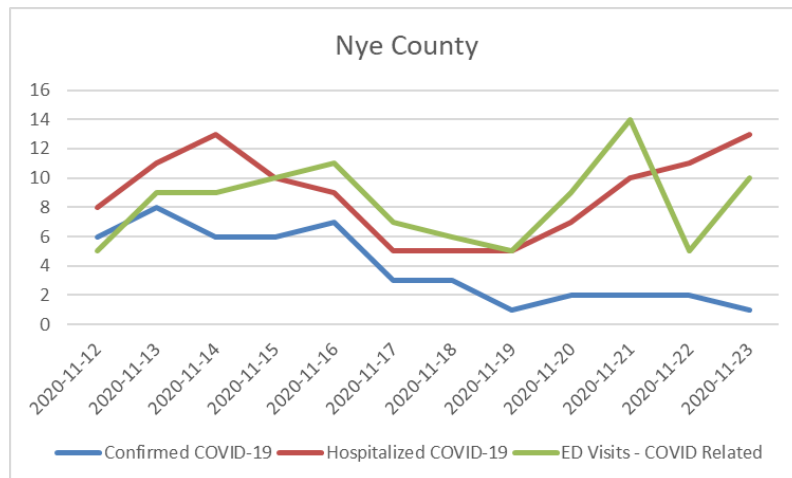
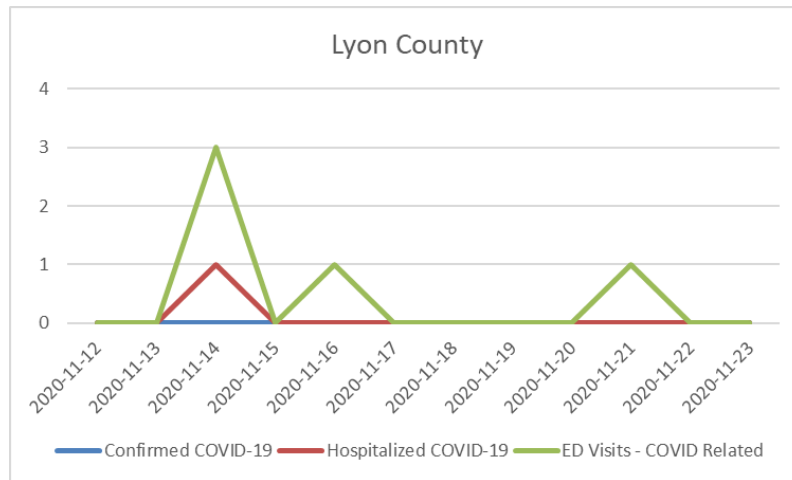
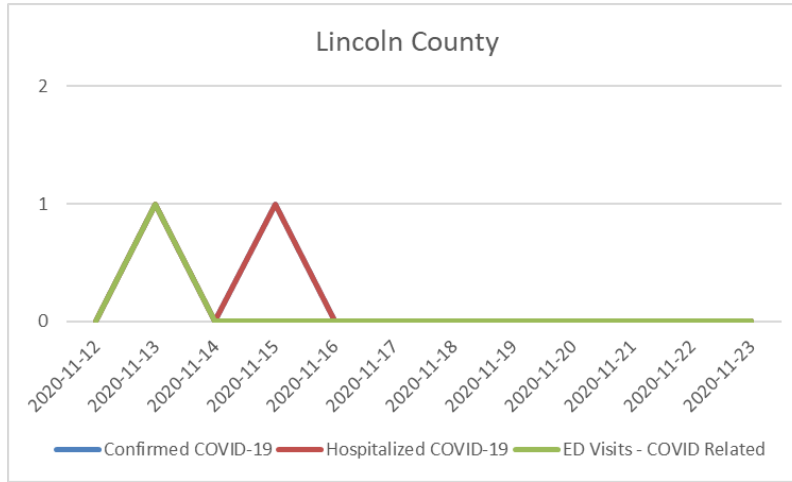
Southern Nevada Data Set
